The Board requested quotes from landscape vendors who would be able to clean up the

areas discussed. The Board also asked for photos and a list of phases that are the responsibility of the CDD and requested that this information be provided by May 1.

Revenues

On-Roll Assessments

The District can levy a Non-Ad Valorem assessment on all the assessable property within the District in order to pay for the operating expenditures during the Fiscal Year. Assessments collected via the tax collector are referred to as "On-Roll Assessments."

Off-Roll Assessments

The District can levy a Non-Ad Valorem assessment on all the assessable property within the District in order to pay for the operating expenditures during the Fiscal Year. It is typically collected via the Tax Collector, but it can also be collected via a direct bill (referred to as Off Roll) from the district.

Other Income & Other Financing Sources

Unexpected revenue source.

Carryforward Cash

Anticipated unused income from a prior year which is available as cash for the current year.

Surplus of Carryforward as of YE (Year-End)

Unanticipated unused income from a prior year which is available as cash for the current year.

General & Administrative Expenses

Supervisor Fees

Chapter 190 of the Florida Statutes allows for a member of the Board of Supervisors to be compensated for meeting attendance and to receive up to \$200.00 per meeting plus payroll taxes. The amount for the Fiscal Year is based upon all supervisors attending the meetings.

Directors' & Officers' (D&O) or Public Officials' Liability (POL) Insurance

Supervisors' and Officers' liability insurance.

Trustee Services

The Trustee submits invoices annually for services rendered on bond series. These fees are for maintaining the district trust accounts.

Blackburn Creek CDD Budget Item Descriptions FY 2023 – 2024

Management

The District receives Management and Administrative services as part of a Management Agreement with PFM Group Consulting, LLC. These services are further outlined in Exhibit "A" of the Management Agreement.

Engineering

The District's engineer provides general engineering services to the District. Among these services are attendance at and preparation for monthly board meetings, review of invoices, and all other engineering services as requested by the district throughout the year.

Disclosure

When bonds are issued for the District, the Bond Indenture requires continuing disclosure, which the dissemination agent provides to the trustee and bond holders.

District Counsel

The District's legal counsel provides general legal services to the District. Among these services are attendance at and preparation for monthly board meetings, review of operating and maintenance contracts, and all other legal services as requested by the District throughout the year.

Assessment Administration

The District can levy a Non-Ad Valorem assessment on all the assessable property within the District in order to pay for the operating expenditures during the Fiscal Year. It is typically collected via the Tax Collector. The District Manager submits an Assessment Roll to the Tax Collector annually by the deadline set by the Tax Collector or Property Appraiser.

Reamortization Schedules

When debt is paid on a bond series, a new amortization schedule must be recalculated. This can occur up to four times per year per bond issue.

<u>Audit</u>

Chapter 218 of the Florida Statutes requires a District to conduct an annual financial audit by an Independent Certified Public Accounting firm. Some exceptions apply.

Arbitrage Calculation

To ensure the District's compliance with all tax regulations, annual computations are necessary to calculate an arbitrage rebate liability.

Postage & Shipping

Mail, overnight deliveries, correspondence, etc.

Blackburn Creek CDD Budget Item Descriptions FY 2023 – 2024

Legal Advertising

The District will incur expenditures related to legal advertising. The items for which the District will advertise include, but are not limited to, monthly meetings, special meetings, and public hearings for the District.

Bank Fees

Bank fees associated with the services the District uses with the bank (e.g. remote deposit capture, positive pay, wire transfers, ACH payments, monthly maintenance, etc.).

Miscellaneous

Other general & administrative expenses incurred throughout the year.

Office Supplies

General office supplies as they relate to the District.

Web Site Maintenance

Website maintenance fee.

Dues, Licenses & Fees

The District is required to pay an annual fee to the Department of Economic Opportunity.

Stormwater Management

Expenses related to the effort to reduce runoff of rainwater into streets and lawns.

70% to Stormwater

Expenses related to the effort to reduce runoff of rainwater into streets and lawns. Funds from the Carryforward Surplus are anticipated to be used towards this expense.

General Insurance

General liability insurance.

General Repair & Maintenance

Repair & maintenance of District equipment, plant, or property.

30% to Hardscape

Expenses related to the purchase or maintenance of hard, yet "movable," parts of landscape, such gravel, paving, and stones. Funds from the Carryforward Surplus are anticipated to be used towards this expense.

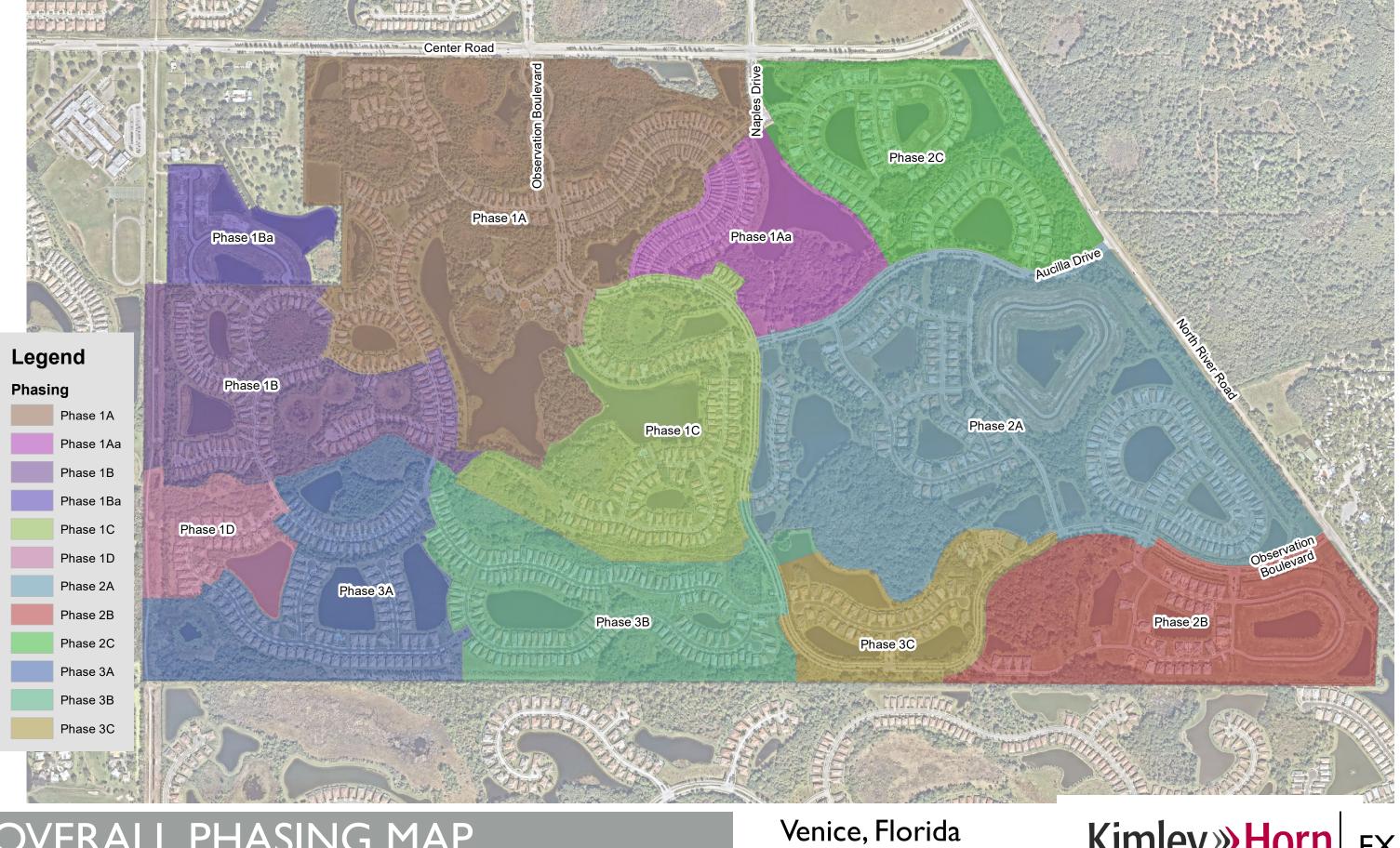

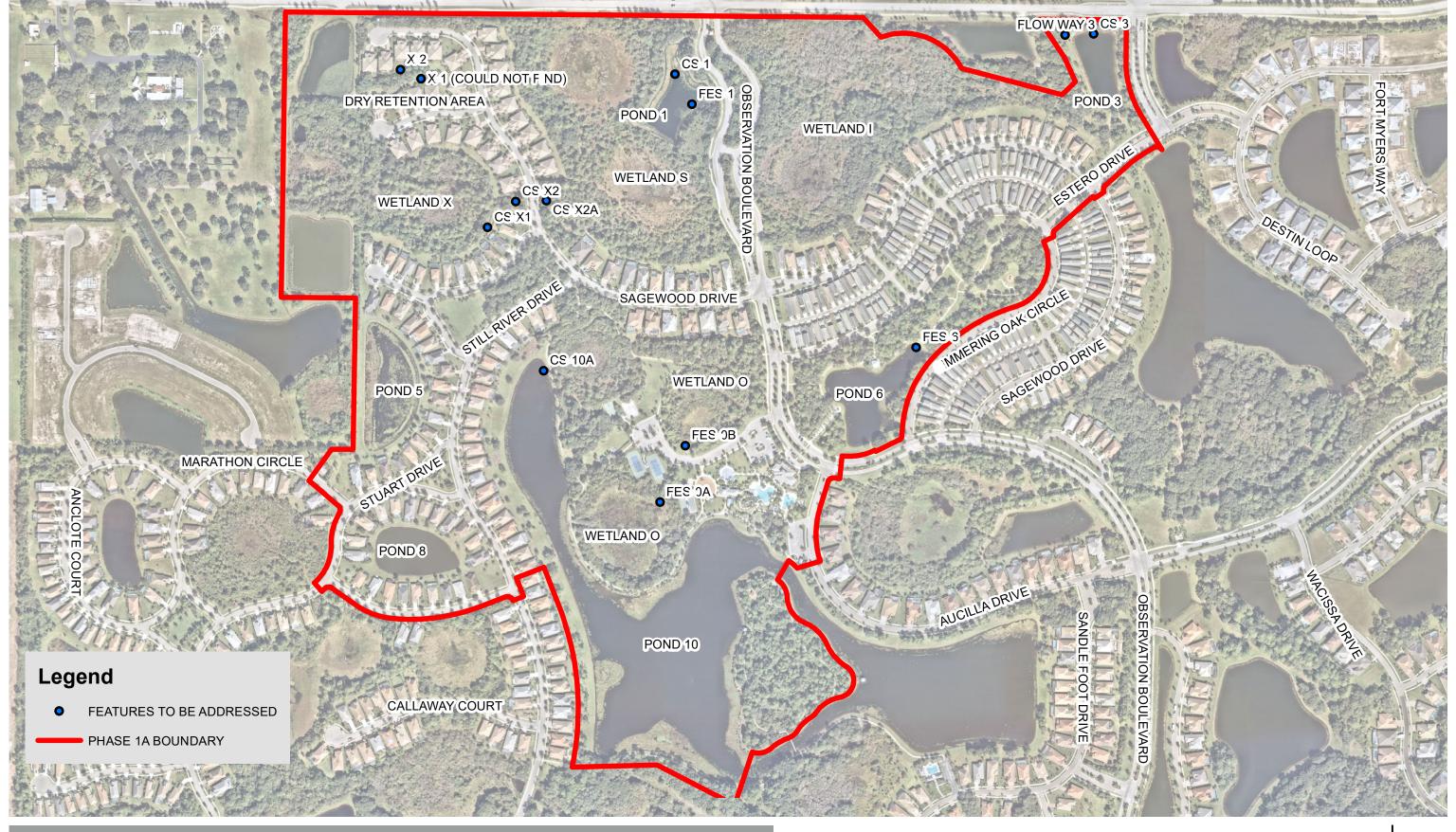

Note: It should be noted that Control Structure CS-X-1 could not be located but is within the Dry Retention Area.

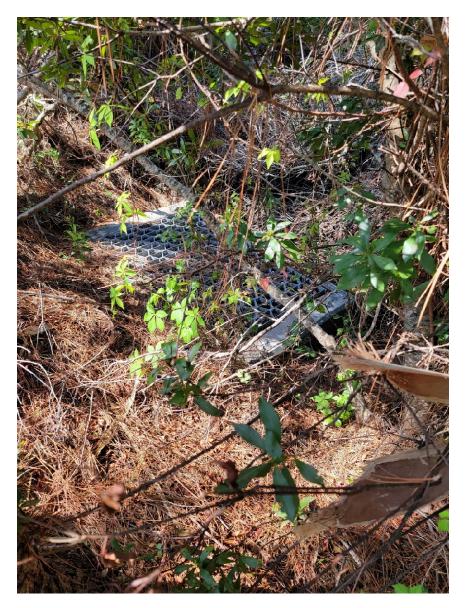
Action: Vegetation and debris to be removed around both control structures.

Flared End Section - FES-1

Rip-rap in the flow way of Flared End Section FES-1. FES-1 is located on the west side of Pond 1, near Observation Boulevard.

Action: Rip-rap in the flow way should be replaced along the outer edges of the structure to prevent erosion.



Control Structure - CS-1

Vegetation in the flow way of Control Structure CS-1. CS-1 is located on the north side of Pond 1.

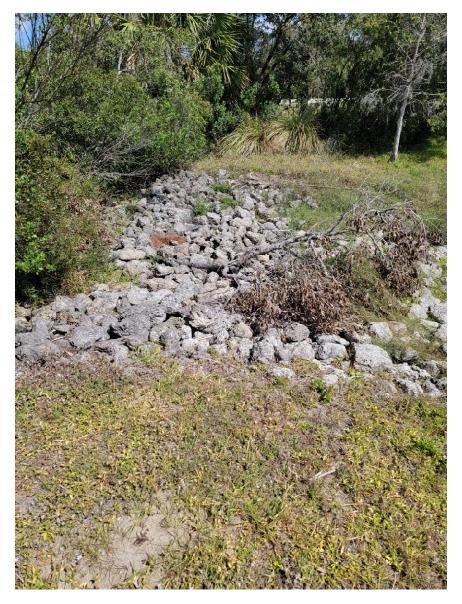
Action: Remove vegetation around the control structure.

Debris and Vegetation in control structure in and around Control Structure CS-3. CS-3 is located on the north side of Pond 3, along Center Road.

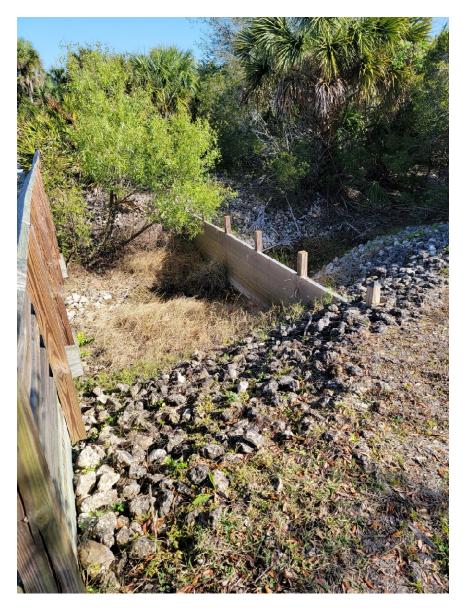
Action: Remove vegetation and debris from in and around the control structure.

Debris and vegetation in Flow Way -3. Flow Way- 3 is located on the northwest side of Pond 3, along Naples Drive.

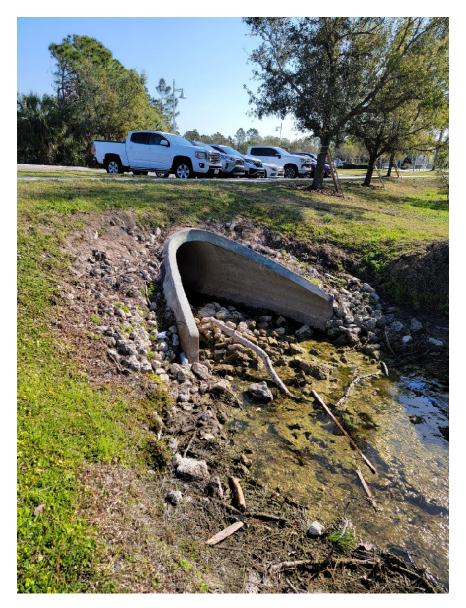

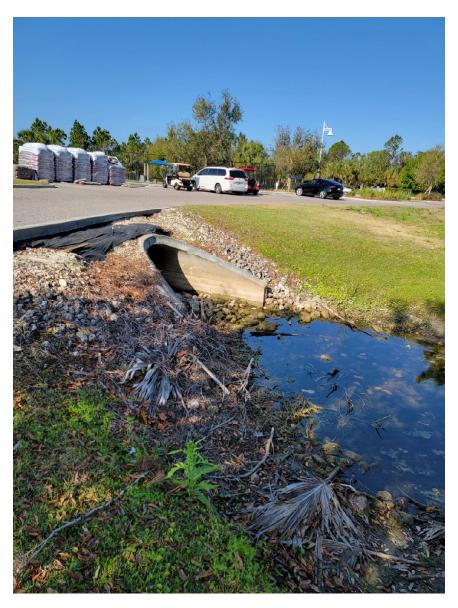

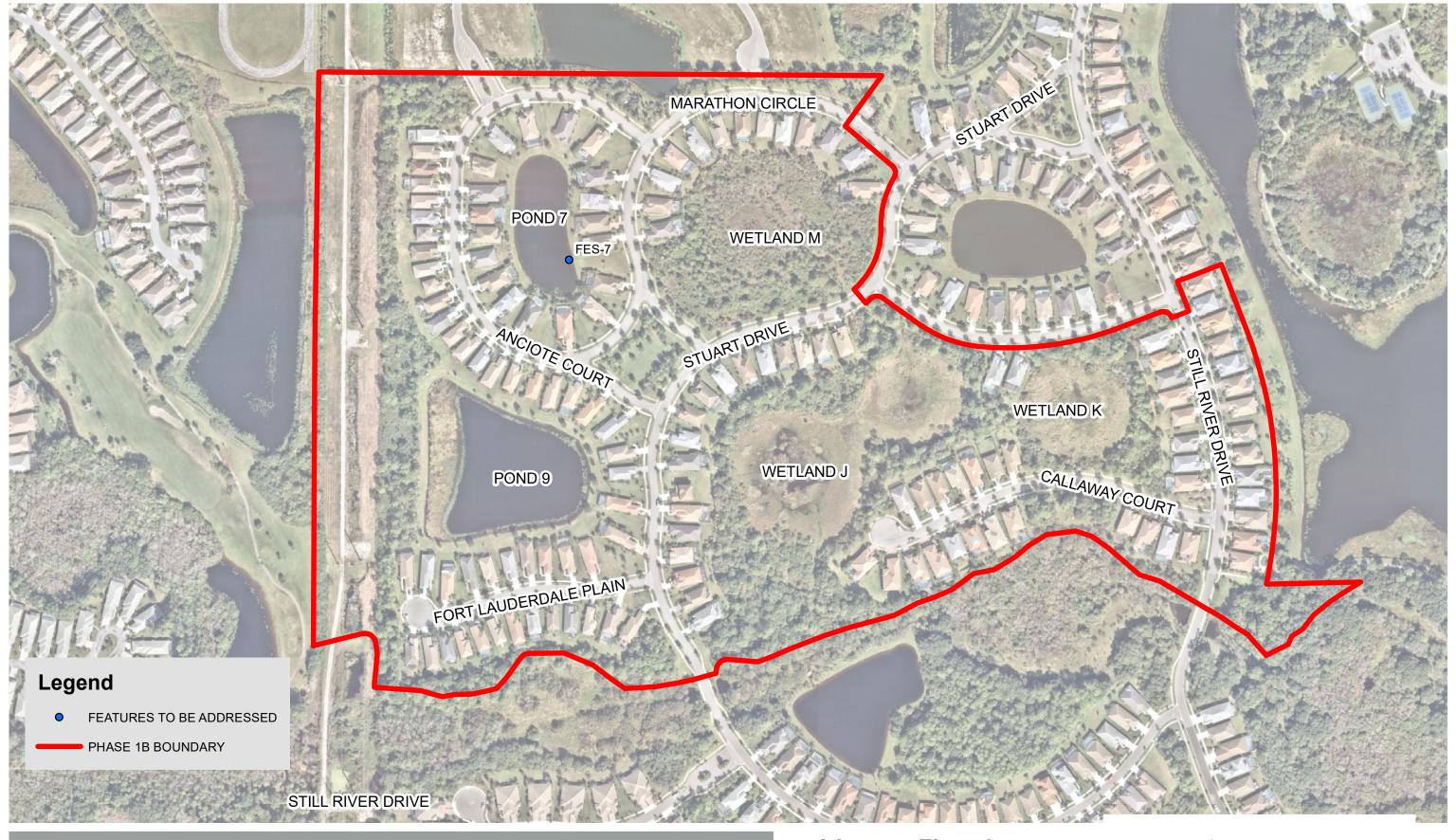
Action: Debris and rip-rap to be removed from the flow way. Rip-rap to be replaced along the sides of the structure to prevent further erosion.

CS-10 SWALE/SKIMMER SECTION BETWEEN POND AND WETLAND

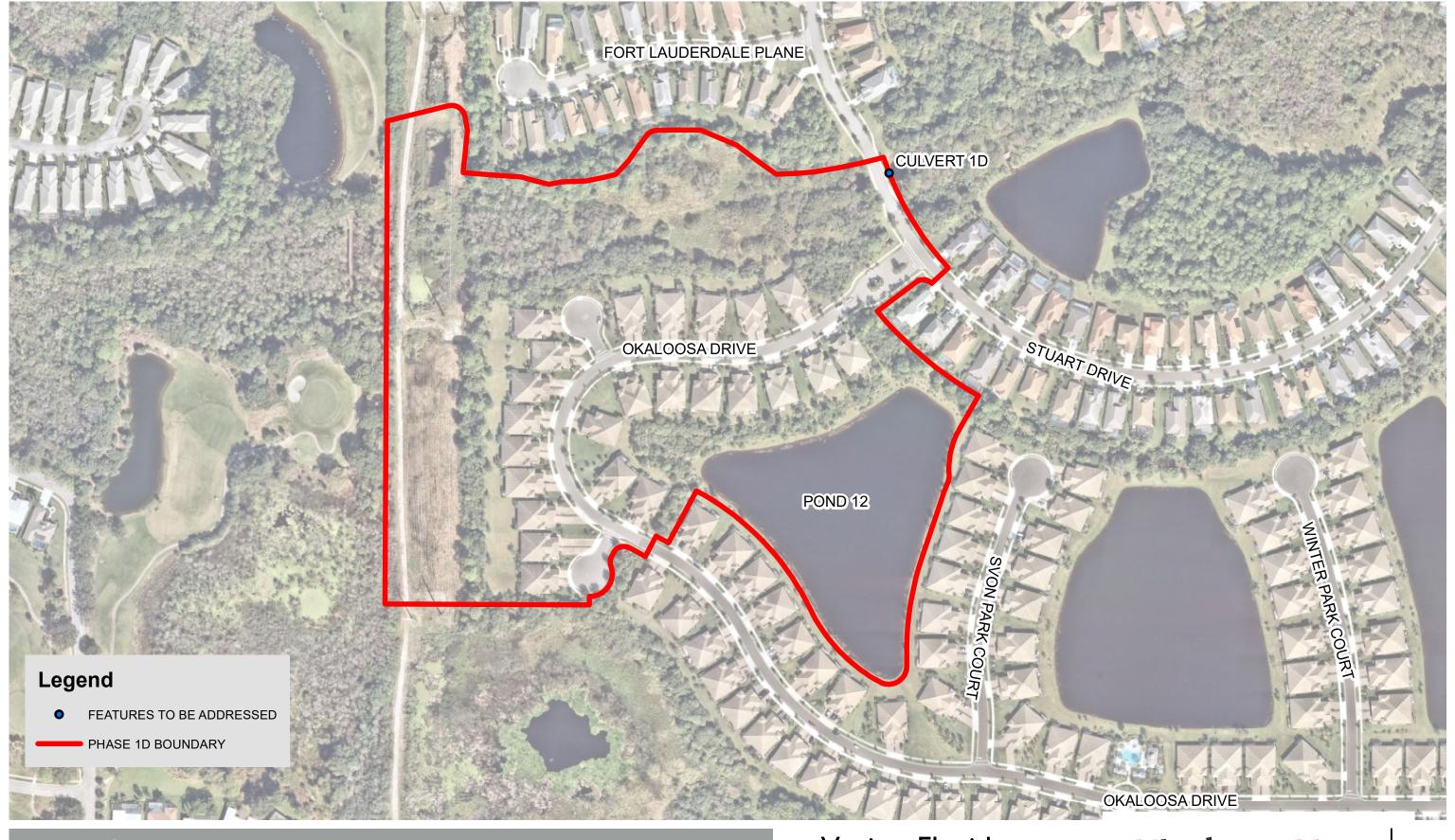
